The acquired some land in the Obarenses Mount slopes, a perfect spot due to its clay-chalk soil sheltered from the winds; vineyards are planted, mostly "tempranillo" grape; they harvest towards the end of October, like in all this far region of the Rioja Alta; and they elaborate the first harvest in a strictly handmade fashion, so, eventually, in 1973, the first wine is obtained.

Once its excellent quality had been contrasted, at the same standard as the best Rioja Alta wines, they commercialized it, increased the number of casks, improved the installations and finally, moved the cellar to some new buildings located in the gardens of the castle and zealously designed to respect the esthetic harmony of the surroundings.

So this is how Castillo De Sajazarra was born, a wine carrying the power of its name.

Solar De Libano Reserva 2003 **Solar De Libano Reserva 2003 (1500ml)** **Solar De Libano Reserva 2003 (5L)**

Medium-dark cherry. Intense and complex. Ripe, plummy fruit blending with the liquorice typical of Tempranillo and the vanilla and coconut contributed by the wood. Medium-bodied, round and smooth in the mouth; sweet tannins and a finish marked by the wood. Persistent length, a very pleasant wine to drink on its own or with food. Very much a Rioja.

Castillo De Sajazarra Reserva 2003 **Castillo De Sajazarra Reserva 2003(1500ml)**

Attractive, deep cherry with violet glints. Intense and complex, blending ripe fruits with the tobacco, spices and medicinal notes contributed by the wood. Creamy, with a solid structure; mature, slightly driving tannins. Harmoniously balanced and long, it is a wine that is splendid now and bodes well for the future.

Digma 2004 **Digma 2005**

Very deep cherry. Intense aroma with finesse and elegance. Perfumed, showing first mature red and black fruits that blend smoothly with clove and nutmeg notes and a subtle creamy hint. Powerful, luscious and mouth-filling, with sweet and mature tannins. A really elegant wine, full-bodied yet retains its fruits and freshness.
